

Terms of hire:

- The Blender Bikes, costumes, stencils and banners are the property of Central Coast Health Promotion Service.
- Items may be hired for a maximum of two weeks. In high-demand periods orders may be only partially fulfilled.
- The school is responsible for pick up and return of items. If unable to return by the due date, please inform us immediately.
- Items are only to be hired for events that promote healthy eating and/or active lifestyles. If food or drink is provided at the event, it must be in line with the NSW Department of Education Student Health and Wellbeing Policy – Healthy Eating Procedures.
- For Blender Bike bookings, a full set of terms and conditions will be sent via email once booking is confirmed. These must be read and agreed to.
- A station wagon with seats collapsed and two people are required to lift and carry the stencils. All stencils must be borrowed together – we are unable to separate stencils for borrowing individually. School to provide own paint and return stencils in a clean state.
- Costumes to be worn by staff members only. If condition of costumes is deemed unsatisfactory upon return, the school will be charged a cleaning fee. If the costumes or pieces of the costume go missing, the school will be charged a replacement fee of \$100.


